Interview with Baran Tarın: How to Prepare for A-Level Exams?

One of the significant milestones in the educational journey, A-Level exams are considered the beginning of a major exam marathon for students. Successfully navigating these challenging exams requires using the right strategies and study methods. Today, we will share the secrets to succeeding in preparing for A-Level exams through the experiences of Baran Tarın with our esteemed readers.

Tan Türkkan: Today, we're with Baran Tarın. As an active student in our school, he will tell us how he prepares for the A-Level exams. Baran, what do you do to prepare for the A-Level exams?

Baran Tarin: First of all, daily study is essential. As you know, the subjects are more challenging, so we can't cram everything in at the last minute. We could succeed in IGCSE exams by studying in the last week, but for A-Levels, daily study is necessary. There are so many topics that we need to regularly study to remember them. This way, we know the subjects like the back of our hand. For example, I now know formulas like the formula for gravity or energy as well as my own name. This happens thanks to daily study.

Tan Türkkan: How do you study? Do you write or read?

Baran Tarın: It depends on the subject. For computer science, I study by writing because this subject requires both reading and writing. There are also topics I need to memorize. In physics and mathematics classes, I listen to the teacher and solve lots of problems. In fact, when I finish the questions, I create new ones for myself. This method of studying is very effective.

Tan Türkkan: It can be challenging to consistently study daily for some people. What would you recommend to friends who struggle with this?

Baran Tarin: Friends, it's normal for some of us to feel lazy sometimes, but once you start studying, staying focused can be tough. Therefore, it's crucial to pay attention in class. Someone who learns well during lectures and listens attentively can succeed with less effort. Understanding the lessons in class makes studying at home much easier.
